



## STORM DRAINS AT YOUR SCHOOL

Storm drains play an important part of preventing water damage from exterior water intrusion. The following are recommended solutions to minimize water intrusion into buildings and structures.

1. Prevent storm drain backups by routinely checking and removing debris in the drain prior to and during the rainy season.
2. If there is debris present in storm drains notify district personnel to have it cleared out.
3. Ensure that the grate covering the drain is secured, in place and free of damages. This is to make sure that large debris does not enter the storm drain and cause a blockage.

The weather cannot be predicted but we can make a proactive effort to reduce or prevent water related losses by maintaining storm drains.
